ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible to receive a Scholarship, the applicant must:



Be due to graduate and confer in 2024 and be able to obtain provisional QCT Registration prior to the commencement of the 2025 School Year. *Mid-year graduates in 2025 and PTT applicants due graduate in 2024 to are also encouraged to apply.



Eligible locations include EMERALD, GLADSTONE, MACKAY, ROCKHAMPTON and BUNDABERG

SCHOLARSHIP CONDITIONS



Scholarships are available to high achieving pre-service teachers who demonstrate professional knowledge, practice and engagement, provide evidence of successfully passing the Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education, support the Catholic ethos and mission and are eligible for employment as a graduate secondary teacher to commence in 2025.



High achieving graduates will be identified on the basis of professional experience reports, application responses and referee statements.

HOW TO APPLY

1 All interested applicants are required to complete an application on the Careers Opportunity Page on the Catholic Education - Diocese of Rockhampton website (Select Graduate Teachers > Graduate Secondary Teacher Scholarship Program).

2 Submit your application by ***28 October 2024*** and provide the following:

- Resume
- Cover Letter
- Selection Criteria Response
- Copies of 1st, 2nd and 3rd professional experience placement reports (available at time of application) and date of your final professional experience placement (if known)
- Three nominated professional referees with at least one referee being a teaching mentor from a practicum

SELECTION PROCESS

Applicants will be contacted as soon as possible following receipt of application by a representative of your nominated College. Applicants will be interviewed by a panel including a member of the College Leadership Team.

Early offer of permanency and appointment for successful Scholarship applicants can occur in line with College appointment processes that occur throughout the year. Initial payment of \$500 will occur upon receipt of your acceptance.
