

PAT (Progressive Achievement Test) in Week 2

Every year, students in Years 7-10 complete ACER's PAT-Mathematics and PAT-Reading test in Term 1 and Term 4. These tests are evidence-based, and content is drawn from the Australian Curriculum.

Early testing in Term 1 allows teachers to know students' understanding and skills quickly and plan accordingly. Term 4 testing results can highlight patterns and identify growth.
