 - b. Care of the instrument
- VIII. The instrument will be returned at the end of Semester II on a date set by the Director of Instrumental Music.
 - IX. Cleaning of the instrument and instrument case is required prior to the return of the instrument
 - Parents / Caregivers should endeavour to cover the loaned instrument under House X. and Content Insurance for the Term of the loan as all breakages must be paid for.
