- III. The instrument is returnable upon the demand at any time for inspection by the instrumental music teacher.
- IV. The instrument must be brought to school for every instrumental lesson and ensemble rehearsal.
- V. Loss or damage of the instrument should be reported immediately to the instrumental teacher.
- VI. If damages occur to the instrument or to any provided equipment (including but not limited to, instrument case, instrument accessories), repairs or replacements are the responsibility of the Parents / Caregivers.
- VII. The loan of the designated instrument may be terminated if a student does not observe the following
 - a. School policy regarding attendance at ensemble rehearsals
 - b. Care of the instrument
- VIII. The instrument will be returned at the end of Semester II on a date set by the Director of Instrumental Music.
- IX. Cleaning of the instrument and instrument case is required prior to the return of the instrument
- X. Parents / Caregivers should endeavour to cover the loaned instrument under House and Content Insurance for the Term of the loan as all breakages must be paid for.

I authorise the student to accept the loan of the instrument described above and I agree to undertake reasonable supervision of its use. I further agree to the conditions of the loan as stated above.
