Principal's Report

ANZAC Day parade was a great example from TCC and other schools of young people showing their respect and giving up their time
About 100 TCC students also attended the dawn service

Boys' Boarding are very thankful for the BBQ and tables that the P&F provided and the school will be attaching a plaque to acknowledge our contribution

A plaque will also be displayed in the Tiered Learning Centre and the donated books for the library will be stamped with an acknowledgement to the P&F

National Catholic Education Commission has highlighted three key issues for the upcoming election

1. Increased capital funding
2. More resources for early childhood education
3. Religious freedom in schools

MySchool website shows that TCC have invested \$13.6M in capital expenditure over the last three years, in comparison to Rockhampton Grammar who invested \$8.8M

New Sports Uniform Committee comprising of three mothers have met
Proposing to phase in new shorts

Looking at replacing the collar of the current sports shirts with a thick strip of the house colour and putting the crest of the house on the right sleeve
Year 11 Advisory Council would like to see the cap changed to a mesh version that breathes better

Enrolments for 2020 have been received and there has been an overwhelming response of 328 application for approximately 224 positions
This means that a third of applicants will be rejected which is not a problem experienced anywhere else except for some elite schools in Brisbane
Interviews are underway
