

Dear Parishioners,

With the lifting of some restrictions by Queensland Health, I will be opening St Joseph's Cathedral and St Paul's Church Gracemere this weekend, 20 – 21 June for the Celebration of Mass.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING :

- The Cathedral Parish have opted to comply with the Industry COVID Safe Plan.
- Masses in the Cathedral will be limited to 100 people (babies included)
- All persons (excluding household members/families) will sit socially distanced at 1.5meters in groups of 20.
- The Priests, Readers, Musicians will be included in one '1' of these groups of 20.

St Paul's Church

- There will be 30 persons (babies included) socially distanced (1.5meters) allowed at St Paul's

Finally, I emphasise if the conditions as outlined in the Industry COVID Safe Plan in respect to cleaning the churches after each mass are not met, I will have to cancel masses.
