

Academic Excellence Awards Criteria

Gold, Silver and Bronze Awards are awarded using a grade point average (GPA).

GPA (15-point scale)

Year Level	Gold Award	Silver Award	Bronze Award
Year 7	13	12.25	11.5
Year 8	13	12.25	11.5
Year 9	12.75	12.20	11.5
Year 10	12.75	12.20	11.5
Years 11 & 12	12.75	12	11.5

In addition, the result of the Religion subject studied, must match the student's results of similar Humanities and English subject results.

These GPAs are based on the following minimum grades using the A+ to E- grading system.

Conversion Table: A+ to E- (15 point scale)

Grades of A+ to E- are given numeric values in order to calculate the GPA. For example, a Year 10 student who achieved the following results; 2A, 3A-, 1B+, 1C for 7 subjects would have a GPA = $(28+39+12+8)/7 = 12.43$. The Year 10 student would receive a **Silver Award**.
